

# VALUE SCALES

## GRAYSCALE VALUE:

--	--	--	--	--	--	--	--	--	--

To create a grayscale value scale, use black.

Begin with the lightest possible pressure in the box on the left. Increase pressure with each box. Use the heaviest possible pressure in the box on the right.

## COLOR VALUE:

--	--	--	--	--	--	--	--	--	--

To create a color value scale, use the color of your choice. Begin with the lightest possible pressure in the box on the left. Increase pressure with each box. Use the heaviest possible pressure in the box on the right.

## COMBINED COLOR & GRAYSCALE VALUE:

--	--	--	--	--	--	--	--	--	--

To create a combination value scale, begin with black. Begin with the lightest possible pressure in the box on the left. Increase pressure with each box. Use the heaviest possible pressure in the box on the right. Repeat the process with the color of your choice.

These instructions are written for right-handed artists. If you're left-handed, start each scale on the right and work toward the left.
